WASTE PAPER

Newspapers, magazines. brochures,

books and catalogues, letters.

writing paper, notebooks. cardboard

corrugated paper. deep freeze cardboard boxes

ORGANIC WASTE

Coffee filters. tea bags, fruit- and

vegetable waste. meat- and food leftovers, bones and eggshells, paper napkins, small animal manures, indoor plants. cut flowers,

grass clippings. hedge trimmings and brush,

windfalls, foliage. crop residues.



YELLOW BAG/YELLOW BIN

Plastic and composite packaging, plastic bottles (PET,...), bottles of detergents,

cleaning agents and body care products, margarine- and yoghurt tubs, fruit bowls and cups, canisters (vinegar, cleaning agents..), plastic foils and bags, polystyrene packaging (balls, chips,...), ceramic bottles.

deep freeze packaging (coated), tetra packs (milk and juice), wooden crates. fruit- and vegetable nets,

jute bags, bonded materials (beverage- and

coffee packets, blisters, ...).

cartridges (soda water, whipped cream,...), empty aerosol cans.

USED TEXTILES

Not available at all collection points!

USED COOKING OIL AND FATS

Fill them into "NÖLI"containers, hand "NÖLIs" in at collection centres.



TETRAPACKS

Collection in ÖKO-BOXES or BAGS. Return: Post office or collection centre.

BUILDING RUBBLE Disposal may vary from community to community. Never use residual waste bin! Mostly by means of rubble containers at collection centres or rubble sites.

BRING-SYSTEM TO COLLECTION CENTRE:



BULKY WASTE

Bulky waste that is too big for refuse bins and

cannot be recycled, such as furniture, carpets, mattresses, washbasins, ceramic toilets, wood wool slab, gypsum board, facade polystyrene etc.



SCRAP IRON

Scrap metal and small metals, e.g. ovens, kitchen

stoves, boilers, bicycles, bathtubs, fences, roof gutters, tubes, sheet metals, metal racks, household small metals (that are not packaging), e.g. tinware, cutlery, metal tools.



WASTE WOOD

Any untreated and treated waste wood. e.g. solid wood,

boards, posts, wood slats, chipboards (raw, lacquered or coated), furniture, doors. By no means windows, fully waterproof wood (railway sleepers, masts) or tree trunks and branches.



CARDBOARD PACKAGING

Corrugated paper and big uncoated

packaging board, such as packaging of electrical devices or self-assembly furniture, cardboard cases for fruit and vegetables, dispatch boxes of shipping companies etc.

PROBLEMATIC SUBSTANCES

Dangerous and poisonous waste.

medicines, paint residue (lacquer, dispersion,...), spray cans (deodorants, hair, varnish,...), adhesives and PU-foam cans, chemicals (acids, Ive, solvents,...), plant protection products, oily waste, electrical device.



WASTE BINS:

Residual Waste, Waste Paper, Yellow Bag – For each residual waste bin you will get a paper bin to be collected every 8 weeks and Yellow Bags for free. The Yellow Bags will be handed out once a year (in December) to all households. Additional bags can be obtained at your municipal office. If there is any excess residual waste/waste paper at short notice, you can buy bags for residual waste or waste paper at your municipal office or at the GABL-office. Other bags won't be collected.

Put out your refuse bins – You should put out your refuse bins/bags at the edge of your property (without obstructing traffic) before 06:00 a.m. (but even better the night before the day of collection). The bins must be removed again no later than 24 hours after emptying.

Keep them clean – The owner of the property is responsible for keeping the refuse bins clean.

ORGANIC WASTE BIN OR HOUSE GARDEN COMPOSTING:

Organic waste from kitchens and gardens must be collected separately. A convenient disposal method is the collection in an organic waste bin. It will be emptied 42 times a year and you can buy additional green waste bags for grass clippings and brush at your municipal office or at the GABL-office which will be collected as well.

You can also recycle organic waste in your own garden by means of a compost pile. Professional composting requires some effort, however. But you will obtain your own fertilizer for free – and engage in genuine recycling management.

REFUSE COLLECTION FEE:

Refuse collection assessment – You will be charged for refuse collection every six months (15.03. and 15.09.)

Payment slip, debit order or "Bürgerportal" – You can either pay by means of payment slip or automatic debit order. If you visit the website www.bu-ergerportal.at, you can get your assessment electronically and have permanent access to your account balance.

COLLECTION POINTS FOR USED MATERIALS:

Waste Glass, Metal Packaging (Cans) and Used Textiles – These used materials can be disposed of by putting them into public containers.

Keep the collection points clean:

Please do not put any refuse beside containers! Should the containers be overfilled, please look for another collection point nearby and inform the GABL.

COLLECTION CENTRES FOR USED MATERIALS:

Bulky Waste, Scrap Iron, Waste Wood, Cardboard Packaging – These waste materials can be taken to the public collection centre for used materials (Altstoffsammelzentrum~ASZ). Each private household is entitled to a quota of 5m³ per year for free. Problematic Substances and Used Electrical Devices – Problematic substances include dangerous waste from private households. House-hold quantities thereof and electrical devices are accepted by the ASZ.
